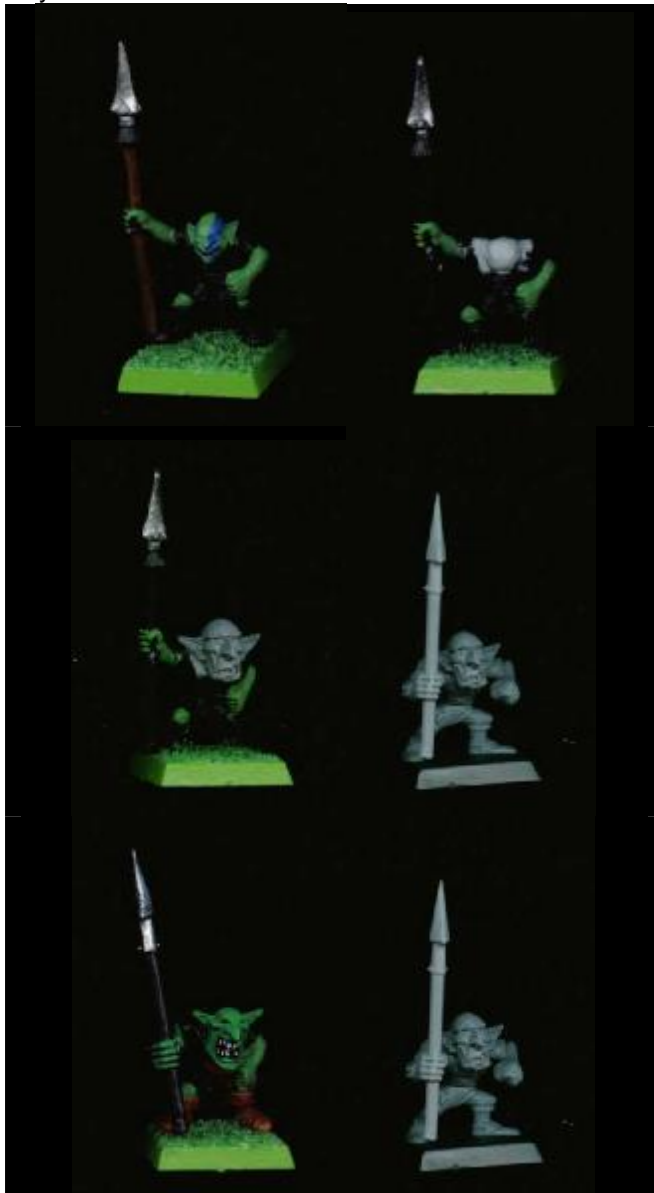


Converting 4th/5th Edition Games Workshop Goblins into 6th Edition

Start off with the standard fourth edition goblin model. It doesn't matter too much if it is painted.

Chop off the top of the head, the face and ears. File the rest down into a lump shape like on the 6th edition models neck.

At this point it is a good idea to add a thin tube of greenstuff around where the neck meets the clothing, but it isn't completely necessary.

It may be a good idea to paint it at this point since it is difficult to do after gluing the head on.

Although some models look a little odd on their own (depending on the head), in a unit it is unnoticeable. It is even less apparent when they are all armed with shields which they should be anyway. To further improve the look of the model you can even cut off the old right arm and stick a new one on
